This policy explains what type of information is collected by the Foundation for VPS and how the information is used. Information collected:

A) Navigation data -

The Foundation for VPS analyzes website logs to track visitor traffic and to improve the value of information available on the website. This information is not personally identifiable.

B) Personal information -

The personal information you provide when you make a donation, sign up to receive emails, register for an event, request assistance, or by other means is used solely for the purposes stated or implied in the collection process.

Use of personal information:

We use your personal information to process your donation and receipt, register you for an event, send email alerts and newsletters, provide a service, etc. You may unsubscribe or customize your communication preferences at any time. All personal information is stored in databases on a secure server. The Foundation for VPS partners with third-parties for the purpose of donation processing and marketing which may require sharing your information. Any data shared with a third-party will be used in accordance with our privacy policy and the privacy policy of the third-party. Your information will only be used for the purposes expressly stated or implied when you provided it. To the extent any donations are processed through a third-party service provider, your information will only be used for purposes necessary to process and record the donation.

The Foundation for Vancouver Public Schools' website and server use the latest encryption technology and firewalls to insure that your information is secure. We do not use cookies on our website. The Foundation for VPS's online payment processing system allows you to make safe donations.
