INVESTING IN VANCOUVER YOUTH

The Foundation for Vancouver Public Schools (VPS) serves over 22,000 youth in 40 schools and programs. Support for the Foundation for VPS helps students by providing essential resources and opportunities for students to reach their full potential, through collaboration and partnership with our community, students, families, and VPS staff. Here's a snapshot of the students we serve:

51.5% of those students qualify for free or reduced lunch, with some schools as high as 80%.

16% are English Language Learners, with 100 different home languages

17.6% are students with disabilities

1,400 students experienced homelessness in the last year

Our district has a longstanding and valued partnership with the Foundation. Through their support, we've been able to offer enrichment and innovation, and they've often been a crucial resource in times of need for our students and families. The strength of a community is evident when people unite to support one another, and the Foundation plays a vital role in facilitating this. 2023-2024 IMPACT AT A GLANCE



BASIC NEEDS & HOUSING

- Housing stability assistance prevented eviction for 239 families impacting 619 youth.
- Over **1**,200 food gift cards were given to support families
- The Foundation had over 73 vision referrals, 31 eye exams, and 68 pairs of glasses given to support students



FAMILY & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

- Family Community Resource Coordinators hosted **136** family engagement nights at their schools
- The VPS Multilingual Welcome Center enrolled over 340 students, connecting their families to valuable resources during the process



ENRICHMENT, ENGAGEMENT, & MENTORING

- \$120,000+ grants were awarded to VPS schools
- 1,695 books, in
 13 different languages were given to students during Read Across America Week

SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL HEALTH & WELL-BEING

- **4,015** students served through mental health clinicians with individual therapy, group therapy and classroom presentations
- \$23,000 was given to schools for Positive Behavior Incentive Supports, which in turn increased attendance and school performance for students

COLLEGE & CAREER READINESS

- **150** students participated in worksite internships that were paid and **8** of those students were immediately hired after completing their internship
- GEAR UP saw **900** students participate in their programming which included support for FAFSA/WAFSA completion and financial aid applications



EARLY LEARNING & SPECIAL EDUCATION

- 144 students participated in evening preschool at 11 schools
- Over **\$19,000** was invested in early learning & special education programs across the district.
